

Revisions to 2024 Contractor Environmental Safety Manual

1. Section 4: ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS, AND FIREARMS

a. Identify KM requirements for contractors that do not fall under DOT.

2. Section 8: CRANES, RIGGING, AND CRIBBING

a. Define Critical Lift and Lift Plan Coordinator requirements.

3. Section 18: HAZARD COMMUNICATIONS

- a. Require contractor to provide KM a hazardous materials list to include quantity, planned use of, storage of and duration of the material will be onsite.
- b. Specific prohibition on PFAS products unless written consent by KM.

4. Section 19: HAZARDOUS ATMOSPHERES

a. Not allowing "passive" gas monitors for continuous monitoring compliance. Requiring 'pump' style.

5. Section 21: JOB HAZARD ANALYSIS/RISK ASSESSMENT

- a. More detailed expectations of Contractors by KM.
- b. Align with Risk Assessment Safety program requirements in ISN.

6. Section 34: SAFETY PERMITS FOR SAFE WORK OR HOT WORK

a. Not allowing "passive" gas monitors for continuous monitoring compliance. Requiring 'pump' style.

7. Section 38: STOP WORK AUTHORITY

a. Add "Responsibility" to section title and definition section.

8. Section 39: TRAINING

a. Remove reference to ISN Training Qualification.

9. Section 41: HEAVY EQUIPMENT – LOADING, UNLOADING, LIFTING

- a. Trained and certified as competent operators only per OSHA 1910.178.
- b. Trained, qualified spotters.
- c. Specifics regarding Excavator, Forklift and other mobile equipment use.
- d. Preference for Lowboy, Landoll, Step Deck type trailers.
 - (1) Deck and ramps to be at least as wide distance from outside wheel to outside wheel.

10. Section 42: WORKING ON, IN, OR NEAR WATER

a. Entire new section focused on MOB, PPE requirements, Rescue, Fall Restraint, Weather and Diving.

11. Section 45: WORKSITE SAFETY

a. Replace service "animals", with service "dogs" to be allowed on-site.

12. Section 59: LAND CLEARING, TRIMMING, MOWING

a. Entire new section focused on PPE requirements, Logging, Mowing & Trimming and Tools.
