- Kinder Morgan is a transportation company with a network of pipelines and terminal facilities in North America.
- Kinder Morgan's Canadian operations are headquartered in Calgary and have about 400 employees. More than 100 staff are located in 10 communities across British Columbia.
- Kinder Morgan is strongly positioned to meet west coast market growth and to support export trade to international markets through its pipeline and marine terminal network. Completion of the Anchor Loop Project in October 2008 increased capacity of the Trans Mountain pipeline by 15 per cent to 300,000 barrels per day.
- A leader in the energy transportation industry, Kinder Morgan was honoured with a 2010 Emerald Award in recognition of its environmental stewardship on the Anchor Loop project.

Trans Mountain Pipeline System

Kinder Morgan transports crude oil and refined petroleum products for its customers through the 1,150 km Trans Mountain pipeline from Edmonton, Alberta to Burnaby, B.C.

Kamloops, Abbotsford and Burnaby Terminals

Products can be temporarily stored along the pipeline in 22 tanks in Kamloops, Abbotsford and Burnaby.



Westridge Marine Terminal

Westridge Marine Terminal

- Located on the southern shore of Burrard Inlet in Burnaby.
- Accommodates ships and barges that transport crude oil to international markets, and stores incoming aviation fuel.
- Ships bound for Westridge Marine Terminal comprise less than 5 per cent of Port Metro Vancouver traffic.



Burnaby Terminal

Jet Fuel Pipeline System

- The 41 km pipeline transports aviation fuel from Burnaby to Vancouver International Airport.
- Tanks at the airport can hold up to three days' fuel supply for airplane refueling.

Puget Sound Pipeline System

- The 110 km pipeline sends crude oil from main pipeline in Abbotsford to refineries in Washington State.

Vancouver Wharves Terminal

- Vancouver Wharves is a bulk marine terminal located at the entrance to Port Metro Vancouver east of the Lions Gate Bridge.
- The facility handles a variety of dry bulk and liquids commodities including mineral concentrates, sulphur, specialty agricultural products, wood pellets and petroleum products.
- Since 2007, Kinder Morgan has completed \$150 million worth of facility expansion and environmental improvements.
