

REX WEST ZONE 1 – PARTIALLY IN SERVICE

Rockies Express announces that portions of Zone 1 of REX-WEST will be in service effective gas day Tuesday, January 1, 2008. Increased capacity will be available using the new Zone 1 assets. All points on the Overthrust system are available via the REX lease; subject to scheduling for any out of path points. Assets not in service at this time include the Meeker and Cheyenne Booster compression, WIC and Echo Springs Receipt points and all of the Zone 2 assets.

Effective for gas day Tuesday, January 1, 2008, applicable recourse rates and FL&U charges for REX West Zone 1 transportation service (\$.2355 per Dth and .62%) apply unless otherwise agreed to. Note that for Rex West Expansion Shippers, Zone 1 service must be nominated under separate existing (or newly requested) transportation contracts until the Interim Service below is available, unless contracts have otherwise commenced by their terms.

As recently posted, Rockies Express anticipates providing Interim Service to the ANR Delivery Point and points upstream on or about January 8, 2008, subject to receipt of final regulatory approvals, weather conditions and continued progress during the commissioning process. Rockies Express will provide updates as progress continues.

Rockies Express continues to expect that full service on the REX system to the PEPL system in Audrain County, Missouri, will be available in early February.
