

Kinder Morgan Energy Partners L.P., Sempra Energy and ConocoPhillips (“Partners”) are jointly pursuing the development of a new natural gas pipeline that would link producing areas in the Rocky Mountain region to the upper Midwest and Eastern United States.

The Rockies Express pipeline will be constructed with 42-inch diameter pipe, sufficient compression and appurtenant facilities to provide transportation capacity of 1.8 billion cubic feet per day. The Partners consolidated the Entrega pipeline system, approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) with Rockies Express.¹

To provide access to major Rocky Mountain supply areas in western Wyoming and to meet an in-service objective of June 2009 for the complete pipeline from the supply areas to Clarington, Ohio, the Partners will seek FERC authorization to expand the Rockies Express pipeline eastward from the Cheyenne Hub, located in Weld County, Colorado through multiple certificate filings. FERC will individually approve or reject each certificate application and approval of one certificate does not guarantee approval of certificates seeking authority to construct additional facilities.

The current status of construction activities for the Rockies Express Pipeline System is as follows:

- Meeker Hub to Cheyenne Hub – In Service
- Cheyenne Hub to Audrain County, MO – FERC authorization received; construction to commence in May 2007
- Audrain County, MO to Clarington, OH – FERC application filed April 30, 2007

¹ On February 23, 2006 Rockies Express acquired 100% of the membership interests in Entrega from Alenco Pipelines Inc., resulting in Entrega becoming a wholly-owned subsidiary of Rockies Express. Rockies Express was merged into Entrega effective April 11, 2006; Entrega continues to exist under the name Rockies Express.
