Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Kinder Morgan Cochin LLC (KM Cochin) submits for filing four copies of the following tariff supplements, effective June 19, 2008 on less than one day's notice:

- Supplement No. 4 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 7 (Cancels Supplement No. 3)
- Supplement No. 2 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 8 (Cancels Supplement No. 1)
- Supplement No. 2 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 17 (Cancels Supplement No. 1)
- Supplement No. 2 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 20 (Cancels Supplement No. 1)
- Supplement No. 2 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 21 (Cancels Supplement No. 1)
- Supplement No. 4 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 22 (Cancels Supplement No. 3)

These supplements are being filed to cancel the embargo applied to F.E.R.C. Tariff Nos. 7, 8, 17, 20, 21 and 22. KM Cochin has completed its hydro testing and Shippers have been notified that beginning June 19, 2008 all destinations will be operational.

KM Cochin requests the waiver of the 30-day filing requirement pursuant to Section 6(3) of the ICA and 18 CFR § 341.14 to file these supplements to be effective June 19, 2008 on less than one day's notice. Shippers will be able to ship to all destinations on the pipeline with the cancellation of the embargo. Therefore, KM Cochin is requesting these tariff supplements become effective as soon as possible for shippers to make the movements as listed on the subject tariffs. These tariff supplements are conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.

We are also enclosing herewith one additional copy of this transmittal, including all attachments, and respectfully request that it be stamped at the time of filing with the Commission's file stamp and returned for our records.
