Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), SFPP, L.P. (SFPP) submits for filing four copies of the following tariffs, effective July 1, 2009:

- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 175 covers SFPP interstate movements from Sepulveda Junction to Watson (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 165)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 176 covers SFPP interstate movements from Watson and East Hynes to Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C. (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 172)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 177 covers SFPP East Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 174)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 178 covers SFPP West Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 171)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 179 covers SFPP North Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 168)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 180 covers SFPP Oregon Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 169)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 181 - Index of Tariffs (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 170)

SFPP is making this filing in compliance with 18 CFR § 342.3, to index certain existing rates. All rates in the above submitted tariffs are increased from the prior tariffs, except as noted. Attached is a summary table of SFPP tariff rates which includes 2008 and 2009 index ceilings, current rates and proposed rates.

The East Line rates are being increased by the 2009 index, but remain below the maximum ceiling levels as a result of a Section 342.3(a) reduction in those rates effective May 1, 2009, which was done pursuant to a settlement with certain East Line Shippers.


