In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), SFPP, L.P. (SFPP) submits the following tariffs for filing in compliance with 18 CFR § 341.4(f) and the Commission's Order issued March 30, 2007 in Docket No. IS06-137-000.

The following Suspension Supplements are filed in compliance with 18 CFR § 341.4(f) and contains an issue date of April 5, 2007.

The Commission's Order stated that the litigation surcharge of 0.41 cents per barrel is rejected. As a result, the following FERC Tariff Nos. 149 – 154 cancels the litigation surcharge and any associated language.

- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 149 – Rules and Regulation (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 143)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 150 covers SFPP interstate movements to Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C. (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 144)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 151 covers SFPP East Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 145)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 152 covers SFPP West Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 146)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 153 covers SFPP North Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 147)
- F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 154 covers SFPP Oregon Line Interstate movements (Cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 148)

SFPP requests the waiver of the 30-day filing requirement pursuant to 6(3) of the ICA and 18 CFR § 341.14 to file FERC Tariff Nos. 149 – 154 on less than one day's notice. SFPP needs to cancel the ULSD litigation surcharge and associated language per the Commission Order issued March 30, 2007 rejecting the litigation surcharge. FERC Tariff Nos. 149 – 154 is a clerical filing to remove the litigation surcharge and associated language. Therefore, SFPP is filing FERC Tariff Nos. 149 – 154 on less than one day's notice. SFPP understands that FERC Tariff Nos. 149 – 154 are conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period
