

CORRECTION SUPPLEMENT

LOCAL TARIFF APPLYING ON REGULAR AND INCENTIVE VOLUME PROPANE

From
Points in the Provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan
To
Points in the Provinces of Saskatchewan and Ontario

The rate named in this tariff is for the transportation of Propane by pipeline subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in Cochin Pipe Lines Ltd.'s (now Kinder Morgan Cochin ULC) tariff N.E.B. No. 6, Supplement No.3, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, and subject to the specific Rules and Regulations published herein (refer to page 2).

The rate listed in this tariff is applicable on the Canadian movement only of Propane tendered at receiving points in Canada, for delivery by Kinder Morgan Cochin ULC to delivery points in the United States or redelivery to Cochin at the International Boundary near Windsor, Ontario. The movement in the United States is subject to tariffs published by Kinder Morgan Cochin LLC which are filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in the United States.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING CORRECTION

Column C of the Table of Rates erroneously shows a Storage Volume Rate between Regina Station, Saskatchewan and the International Boundary near Alameda, Saskatchewan. Below is the correction cancelling the Column C rate from Regina Station, Saskatchewan as well as Item 25 Storage Volume.

[C] ITEM 25 STORAGE VOLUME

~~The total volume shipped into Regina Station, Saskatchewan from the Fort Saskatchewan Terminal, Alberta by each Shipper during the months of April, May, June, July and August (the storage volume) shall earn the same Shipper the right to ship an equal volume from Regina Station, Saskatchewan to the International Boundary near Alameda, Saskatchewan during the ensuing months of September through March at the rates set forth in Column C, the Storage Volume Rate, in the Table of Rates. Any volumes shipped by each Shipper from Regina Station, Saskatchewan to the International Boundary near Alameda, Saskatchewan during the months of September through March in excess of the storage volume of said Shipper shall be billed at the rates contained in Column B, the Incentive Volume Rate, in the Table of Rates in the event that said Shipper has earned incentive volume credits by shipping from Regina Station, Saskatchewan to the International Boundary near Alameda, Saskatchewan during the months of April, May, June, July and August. Any volumes shipped by each Shipper from Regina Station, Saskatchewan to the International Boundary near Alameda, Saskatchewan during the months of September through March in excess of the storage volume plus the incentive volume earned by said Shipper shall be billed at the rates contained in Column A, the Regular Volume Rate, in the Table of Rates.~~
