Dear Mr. Young:

Further to the Board's letter of April 10, 2007 extending the deadline for Cochin to respond to the Board's IRs, we are pleased to report that Spectra and Cochin have been able to resolve Spectra's concern. Spectra has sent us the attached letter stating that they do not oppose the Revised Tolls taking effect April 1, 2007. The resolution of this matter is reflected in the attached revised Tariff Sheets.


Based on the foregoing, and upon the support or non-objection of other Cochin customers earlier communicated to the Board (additional support has been recently received from SemStream, a copy of which is also attached hereto), Cochin asks the Board to cease its process of reviewing the complaints the Board received regarding Cochin's new rates. As Cochin understands it, the effect of this cessation would be for the final rates as reflected in the attached Tariff Sheets to take effect as indicated. Immediately upon the Board's decision to cease its process, affirming the revised filed rates, Cochin will proceed to make the necessary adjustments to its customers' accounts where the interim toll revenue collected differs from the toll revenue applicable under the attached final and "in effect" rates, and refund or invoice for that difference as appropriate.

In the attached Tariff Sheets, we have also changed the name of the company to reflect the recent acquisition by Kinder Morgan.

These Tariff Sheets reflect the effective date of April 1, 2007 as agreed upon by Cochin and its shippers.

Spectra Energy Empress L.P. ("Spectra") is a shipper on the Cochin Pipe Lines Ltd. ("Cochin") system. Spectra participated in recent discussions between Cochin and its shippers aimed at resolving concerns arising from Cochin's tariff filed with the Board on 22 December 2006 and made interim by Order TOI-03-2006 effective 1 January 2007.


As a result of the discussions between Cochin and its shippers, including Spectra, Cochin has agreed to revise its tariff and re-file the tariff with the Board. The tolls that were in effect in December 2006 will be applied to volumes shipped in January, February and March 2007 and the new tolls will come into effect as of 1 April 2007 ("Revised Tolls").

Spectra understands that Cochin's tolls are regulated on a complaints basis. Spectra is aware of how the Revised Tolls have been calculated, has had opportunity to discuss the Revised Tolls with Cochin and does not object to the Revised Tolls.

In light of the agreed-upon revisions to the Cochin tariff, Spectra does not oppose the Revised Tolls taking effect on April 1, 2007.

SemStream, L.P. is a shipper on the Cochin Pipe Lines Ltd. ("Cochin") system. **SemStream, L.P.** participated in recent discussions between Cochin and its shippers aimed at resolving concerns arising from Cochin's tariff filed with the Board on 22 December 2006 and made interim by Order TOI-03-2006 effective 1 January 2007.

As a result of the discussions between Cochin and its shippers, including **SemStream, L.P.**, Cochin has agreed to revise its tariff and re-file the tariff with the Board. The tolls that were in effect in December 2006 will be applied to volumes shipped in January, February and March 2007 and the new tolls will come into effect as of 1 April 2007 ("Revised Tolls").

SemStream, L.P. understands that Cochin's tolls are regulated on a complaints basis. **SemStream, L.P.** is aware of how the Revised Tolls have been calculated, has had opportunity to discuss the Revised Tolls with Cochin and does not object to the Revised Tolls.

In light of the agreed-upon revisions to the Cochin tariff, **SemStream, L.P.** supports (does not oppose) the Revised Tolls taking effect on April 1, 2007. **SemStream, L.P.** will not initiate a complaint, directly or indirectly, concerning the Revised Tolls for one year from the effective date of the Revised Tolls. If at any time Cochin proposes that the Revised Tolls be superseded by higher tolls, then **SemStream, L.P.** may complain to the NEB about Cochin's proposed replacement tolls.
