Re: Advice Letter No. 12 of Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C.

Dear Mr. Royer:

Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C. (“Calnev”) hereby submits for filing six copies of the following proposed tariff schedules that govern the transportation of petroleum products by pipeline:

- Cal PUC No. 11 – a new Rules and Regulations tariff which cancels the rules and regulations in Cal PUC tariff No. 10.
- Cal PUC No. 12 – a new local tariff which cancels the rates and routing in Cal PUC tariff No. 10.

We are asking for the acceptance of this filing on a short notice so that the effective date of July 1, 2002, can coincide with a similar filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

These proposed tariffs do not change the rates.

Calnev is making this filing for three reasons: 1) to make its rules and regulations match, where possible, the rules and regulations of the originating carrier; 2) to advise shippers and other users how to obtain supplemental policies and forms from Carrier’s website; and 3) to put the rules and regulations in a separate tariff from the rates and routing tariff.

Comparison tables showing the changes in Cal PUC No. 11 from the rules and regulations in Cal PUC No. 10 can be found at the end of the proposed tariff.

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact. Protests must be made in writing and not later than twenty days after the date of this Advice Letter. The protest should be addressed to:


