Re: Advice Letter No. 13 of Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C.

Dear Mr. Royer:

Calnev Pipe Line, L.L.C. (“Calnev”) hereby submits for filing six copies of the following proposed tariff schedule that govern the transportation of petroleum products by pipeline:

- Cal PUC No. 13 – a new Rules and Regulations tariff which replaces the rules and regulations in Cal PUC tariff No. 11.

This proposed tariff does not change the rates in the current local tariffs.

Calnev is making this filing for the following reasons:

- Add Item 70.5 under Acceptance of Petroleum Products: Shipper holds title to product shipped;
- Add Item 100.2 under Tender of Petroleum Products: System operates 24 hours a day;
- Add reference to Calnev’s Connection Policy in Item 230 - Connection to System and give instructions for accessing this policy on the company website; and
- Minor wording changes to Items 90.1, 120.1, 240.2 and Reference Marks.

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact. Protests must be made in writing and not later than twenty days after the date of this Advice Letter. The protest should be addressed to:
