An Incident means any of the following events:

- (1) An event that involves a release of gas from a pipeline or of a liquefied natural gas or gas from an LNG Facility and
  - (i) A death, or personal injury necessitating in-patient hospitalization; or
  - (ii) Estimated property damage, including cost of gas lost, of the operator or others, or both, of \$50,000 or more.
- (2) An event that results in an emergency shutdown of an LNG facility.
- (3) An event that is significant, in the judgment of the operator, even though it did not meet the criteria of paragraphs (1) or (2).
