Attention Railroad Commission of Texas:

In accordance with the requirements of the Railroad Commission of Texas, Double Eagle Pipeline LLC ("Double Eagle") submits for filing the following tariffs, to be effective September 1, 2019:

- RCT No. 21, Rules and Regulations Tariff (cancels RCT No. 14)

The purpose of this filing is to revise the Merchantable Oil table found in Section II Item 24 and add a new Quality Bank in Section II Item 230 of RCT No. 21, Double Eagle's Rules and Regulations Tariff. The following changes to RCT No. 21 are intended for the general grade common stream: (i) the API Gravity range of the general grade common stream has been expanded to 38 to 53 API; and (ii) a new Quality Bank has been added to administer the general grade common stream. No changes were made to the existing chemical grade condensate common stream or the calculation of its Quality Bank.
