**ITEM 20 - RATES AND CHARGES FOR MOVEMENTS  
 THROUGH SHIPPER IN-TRANSIT STORAGE**

<p>Applicable rates and charges from Shipper in-transit storage location to final Destination shall be the sum of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Injection Charge – 1.0 cent per Barrel, the provisions of which do not apply to Origin locations.</li> <li>(2) Transportation Rate – The difference between the rates, Baton Rouge, LA to in-transit storage location and Baton Rouge, LA to final Destination, in effect at the time shipments reenter Carrier's System.</li> </ul>
<p>The provisions of the above injection charge and transportation rate do not apply to movements under proportional rates. It being impracticable to maintain the absolute identity of Petroleum Products stopped in-transit; reasonable substitution of Barrels of the same kind of commodity shall be permitted.</p>
<p>Volume deduction (Item 110.3 of Carrier's Rules and Regulations Tariff) will not apply to volumes reentering Carrier's System from in-transit tankage provided by Shipper.</p>

<b><u>EXPLANATION OF REFERENCE MARKS</u></b>	
①	Volumes from Mississippi origins to Mississippi destinations are intrastate application only. In addition to the other grades of gasoline that can be moved on the system, Shippers may nominate the movement of V Grade gasoline.
