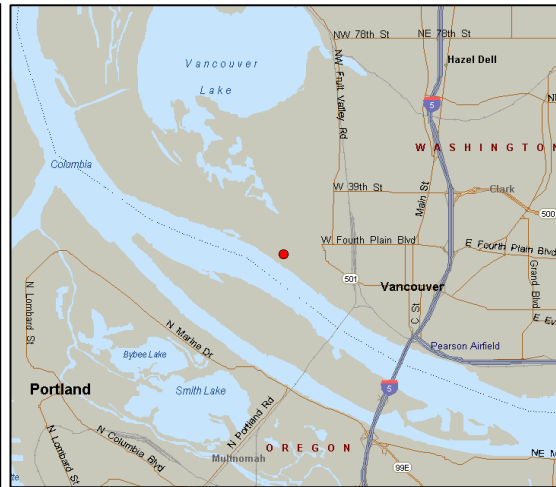

- Interstate access via I-5 and I-84; highway access via State Route 14
- Rail access from BNSF and Union Pacific
