

UTICA MARCELLUS TEXAS PIPELINE LLC

NOTICE OF OPEN SEASON EXTENSION

On June 17, 2015, Utica Marcellus Texas Pipeline LLC, a Kinder Morgan subsidiary (“Carrier”), announced a binding open season (“Open Season”) for potential development of a pipeline system (“UMTP System”) designed to transport propane, butanes, natural gasoline, Y-grade, or condensate (“Products”) in batches from points of origin in Harrison and Tuscarawas Counties, Ohio to destinations on the Texas Gulf Coast. In its notice, Carrier indicated that the Open Season would close at 5:00 p.m. CST on Tuesday, September 15, 2015. The market has shown significant interest in the UMTP System and in the interest of permitting continued negotiations with interested parties, Carrier has agreed to extend the Open Season until 5:00 p.m. CST on December 15, 2015. Consistent with Carrier’s initial announcement, notice of this extension of the Open Season is posted to <http://www.kindermorgan.com/>.

Except for this change in the closing date of the Open Season, all other terms and conditions of the Open Season remain in full force and effect.

An entity that desires to become an Anchor Shipper must execute and deliver to Carrier, consistent with the terms of the confidential Binding Open Season Terms and Procedures, two copies of the applicable TSA for each form of commitment selected on or before the date and time indicated above. As previously indicated, Carrier reserves the right to terminate and/or further extend this Open Season, in its sole and absolute discretion, at any time.
