Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), Products (SE) Pipe Line Corporation (PPL) submits for filing the following tariff, effective January 1, 2022:

- FERC No. 155.32.0, Local, Proportional, and Volume Incentive Tariff (cancels FERC No. 155.31.0)

PPL is establishing a new volume incentive for an existing shipper delivering aviation kerosene barrels into the Atlanta Hartsfield Airport. If an existing shipper exceeds their 2021 Monthly Average Volume by 20% ("Volume Threshold") during the term reflected in Item 50.3, they will receive an additional 25 cents per barrel discount. The discount will apply only to the barrels delivered that exceed their Volume Threshold. A shippers' 2021 Monthly Average Volume will equal the total barrels delivered to the Atlanta Hartsfield Airport by shipper during the six month period May 2021 through October 2021 divided by six.


In FERC No. 155.32.0, PPL is extending the expiration date shown in Item 50.3, Airport Volume Incentive Program, which includes the new volume incentive to June 30, 2022. All rates in FERC No. 155.32.0 are unchanged from the prior tariffs.
