Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act ("ICA") and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or "Commission"), SFPP, L.P. ("SFPP") submits for filing the following tariff, effective April 2, 2021:

- FERC Tariff No. 197.18.0, a local tariff covering interstate transportation from El Paso and Diamond Junction, Texas, to Lordsburg, New Mexico, and Tucson and Phoenix, Arizona (SFPP's "East Line"). The Tariff cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 197.16.0.

On March 2, 2021 in Docket No. IS21-257-000, SFPP filed FERC Tariff No. 197.17.0 to reduce the ceiling levels to the level of the reduced rates provided for in the settlement under Rule 602. It has been brought to SFPP's attention that the filing made on March 2, 2021 was inadvertently filed using the incorrect filing code of "1420" (ALJ Settlement in a Part 341 Oil Pipelines Program Proceeding). Therefore, SFPP is making this current filing to correct a filing code error and there are no substantive changes to SFPP's East Line Tariff. The previous filing in Docket No. IS21-257-000 will be withdrawn.

SFPP is including as Attachment A (which is identical to the initial filing in Docket No. IS21-257-000), which is an index summary that identifies the index rate ceiling that will apply to the rates set forth in FERC No. 197.18.0. In particular, Attachment A shows: (1) the current index ceiling levels, (2) the current rates, (3) the index ceiling levels to be effective on April 2, 2021, and (4) the rates that will remain in effect. For clarity, although the index ceiling levels are being adjusted to reflect the Commission's approval of the East Line Settlement under Rule 602, all of the rates set forth in FERC No. 197.18.0 remain unchanged and consistent with the East Line Settlement.

SFPP requests special permission to submit FERC No. 197.18.0 on one days' notice under the authority of 18 C.F.R. §§ 341.14 and 341.2. SFPP submits that good cause exists for granting this request because FERC Tariff No. 197.18.0 makes no changes to SFPP's rates or its terms of service. SFPP acknowledges that this tariff publication is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a thirty-day review period.

SFPP has also revised the cover page of the tariff to reflect the regulation under which this tariff filing is being made. SFPP is making no other changes to FERC Tariff No. 197.16.0.
