Re: Tier 2 Advice Letter No. 55-O of SFPP, L.P. (PLC-9)

Dear ED Tariff Unit:

In accordance with the provisions of General Order 96-B; Rule 5.1 and Energy Industry Rules 5.1(2) and 5.2(2), SFPP, L.P. (“SFPP”) hereby submits its Advice Letter No. 55-0 reflecting revisions to its Cal PUC Rules and Regulations Tariff. These clarifications and revisions are included in Tariff Cal PUC No. 159 Rules and Regulations attached hereto as Attachment A, which will cancel SFPP’s current Cal PUC No. 133. The tariff is scheduled to become effective on June 13, 2026.

First, SFPP is updating the issuer information contained on the cover page of the tariff so that the Commission has the most up-to-date information as to the individual responsible for issuing the tariff.

Second, SFPP is including a new provision in Item 90, Duty of Carrier. Item 90 currently provides, *inter alia*, that SFPP reserves the right to maximize its operational efficiency and capacity through fungible operations in which a reasonable substitution of the same quantity of Petroleum Products meeting the same specifications will be permitted. Consistent with this right, SFPP is adding a new provision that it may, when operationally feasible, provide service via displacement or exchange on a first-come, first-serve basis. SFPP has included this new provision for clarity and to enhance the transportation services it provides to accommodate shipper requests. Displacement or exchange service will only be provided between a published Origin Point-Destination Point pairing, and the then-current tariff rate applicable to such Origin Point-Destination Point pairing, as set forth in SFPP’s CPUC rates tariff, shall apply to any delivery via displacement or exchange.

SFPP is providing a copy of this Tier 2 advice letter to its shippers of record (See Attachment B hereto) in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 96-B.
