In accordance with the requirements of the Railroad Commission of Texas, Kinder Morgan Wink Pipeline LLC (KMWP) submits for filing the following tariff, effective March 1, 2022:

- Tariff No. 31, Local Rate Tariff applying on the intrastate gathering and transportation of crude petroleum (cancels Tariff No. 30).

KMWP has a single committed shipper. All committed shipper rates in the above proposed tariff are decreased from the prior tariff except for the no change in Items 320.4 and 330.2, in accordance with the terms of the committed shipper's transportation services agreement. Therefore, Tariff No. 31 is being filed in order to decrease all rates in this tariff, as shown in Items 300-330, except as noted. Also, KMWP is cancelling the movements to Colorado City, TX due to the inoperability of this section of pipeline and no requests for service.
